#### Recruitment

- O February 2020 is full..... at levels across UK not seen since 2006
- £20,000 incentive for some Scottish programmes
- O Stage 3 bypass score reduced to 550 from 575

#### Foundation

- Scottish Government has decided almost all new foundation posts should be in General Practice
- Currently approximately 25-30% of Scottish FY2s will have a GP post
- O By 2023 this should rise to about 50%
- Across Scotland will mean 159 posts and 477 doctors a year experiencing GP in FY2

- New title to reflect how they collect the evidence for the capabilities
- Some confusion due to different contracts across the UK
- Mapping exercise only
- O The ARCP panels will take a pragmatic approach in January 2020

#### Work Placed Based Assessment 2020

- New set of assessments
- New e-portfolio
- Trainee will change over to new e-portfolio when they change ST year

## Summary of changes

- Reduced workload for ES and trainee
- One ESR annually and shorter mid year review
- Reduce number of CBDs and introduce CATs (in primary care)
- Reduce number of COTs
- Introduce QIP, prescribing assessment, new safeguarding and leadership activities
- Reduce number and length of learning logs
- Stop PSQ in ST1/2 and rewrite PSQ for ST3
- Rewrite forms for COTs, miniCEX and CSR
- 1 less MSF in ST1 and leadership MSF in ST3

## Prescribing assessment

- Mandatory pilot in first half of ST3 year
- Only if full time and starting in GPST3 August 2019
- 60 retrospective prescriptions from a date set by ES
- Computerised or manual search
- Vision and EMIS "fixes" developed
- Likely something similar will continue so complete the feedback!
